A later maturing, tall forage sorghum with strong stalks contributing to excellent standability. **FORAGER 60** will grow 6-7 feet tall and produce a large panicle of red grain. **FORAGER 60** exhibits very wide leaves to produce a dark, dense canopy to aid in weed suppression. **FORAGER 60** is recommended to be planted in rows for silage at a 6-8 pound seeding rate per acre. A great companion for FORAGER 55 to maximize tonnage and spread maturities.
