

# X-TENDER



- A late-maturity (LM) sorghum/sudangrass

The late maturity (LM) concept produces hybrids (sorghum/sudangrass) that are 10-20 days later than conventional sorghum/sudan hybrids. This late maturity allows a wider window for harvest of high quality leaves before boot stage is reached. This hybrid had greater IVTD value and a higher crude protein. IVTD of this hybrid was 20+% more than a commercial check in trials. This hybrid has a wide range of adaptation because of its incredible drought resistance and yield of quality forage.
