

**Sanborn County 4-H Leaders Meeting
July 30, 2009, 4-H Building, Forestburg**

The Sanborn County 4-H Leaders met on July 30, 2009 at the 4-H Building in Forestburg. President Stacy Zoss called the meeting to order at 8:20 pm. Also present were Velma Kneen, Paula Linke, Pam Moore, Kathy Zoss, Vicki Hines, Brooke Zoss and Irene Graves, Extension Educator.

The flag pledges were recited.

Secretary's report: The minutes of the June 24, 2009 meeting were approved as presented.

Treasurer's report: Velma Kneen presented the treasurer's report with balances as follows: Checking - \$2897.32, Savings - \$3930.52, CD - \$1650.00 and Jr. Leaders - \$396.10. We have received \$1195 in 4-H sponsor donations and \$467.75 from horse show concession receipts. We spent \$205.35 for concession stand supplies and \$250 for concession stand cash. Other expenses included \$125.16 for the horse show judge, \$33.03 for project day snacks and \$70.87 for project day supplies. The total cash profit on the horse show concessions was just \$12.40; but we have approximately \$90 in inventory carryover for Achievement Day supplies. It was moved by Paula, seconded by Pam, to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Phonathan: The Phonathan was held on May 19th. Our goal was \$1368 and as of 7/28 we have received \$1495.

Livestock: Livestock registration and papers are due.

Posters and table toppers will be made, and the livestock show MC will announce our sponsors. Motion carried.

Project Day Review: Brooke Zoss & Logan Moody held a project day on July 9th & 16th in Forestburg with Kelsey Suelflow from Aurora County. They had about 13 participants. They made washer necklaces, stepping stones, fabric wall hangings, and marsh mellow shooters. Brooke & Logan also helped Kelsey with her project days in Aurora County.

Achievement Day: The Achievement Day schedule is attached. The Food Committee report, Community Breakfast plans, Face Painting plans and Pie Contest were reviewed.

Concession Stand Prices: It was moved by Vicki, seconded by Pam, to increase prices on concessions. Motion carried.

BBQ Meal: It was moved by Paula, seconded by Kathy, to serve BBQ sandwiches, coleslaw, baked beans, chips, watermelon and drink for the BBQ meal. Motion carried.

BBQ Tickets: Tickets are due August 3rd.

4-H Awards: It was moved by Pam, seconded by Paula, that the winners of Grand Champion and Showmanship be given the choice of a chair, hoodie or gift card, and rate of gain winners receive a trophy. Motion carried.
