

**Sanborn County 4-H Leaders Meeting**  
**May 28, 2008, 8:00 p.m.**  
**4-H Building, Forestburg**

Velma Kneen made a motion that everyone should take a moment to read the secretary's report. Paula Linke seconded the motion. Motion carried. There were no corrections. Velma Kneen made a motion to approve the minutes. Karen Klinkner seconded the motion. Motion carried.

County 4-H Horse Show: To be held on July 1<sup>st</sup> at 8:00 a.m. at the 4-H Grounds in Forestburg. Irene reported that the rock picker went through the arena. Parents will help out as needed. Vickie and Velma are on the Food Stand Committee. Pre-registration for the horse show is June 23<sup>rd</sup>.

4-H Achievement Days: Will be held July 31<sup>st</sup> and August 1<sup>st</sup>. Set up will be July 30<sup>th</sup> starting at 6:30 p.m. with a 4-H Leaders meeting to follow if needed.

July 31<sup>st</sup> at 4:45 p.m. will be orientation of judges. Ellyn is still getting replies back from the judges. From 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. the static exhibits will be entered and interview judging will begin.

On August 1<sup>st</sup> all livestock will be entered and weighed in at 7:00 a.m. The swine show will start at 8:00 a.m. with the dog show, sheep show, and dairy goat/meat goat show to follow. After the lunch break, the beef show will begin at 1:00 p.m. with the cat show, rabbit show, and poultry show to follow. Round Robin showmanship events were discussed.
