

New Resolution Adopted at the 2017 Annual Convention

Electronic Logging Device (ELD) Mandate

WHEREAS, the Electronic Logging Device (ELD) mandate is scheduled to go into effect December 18, 2017, and WHEREAS this mandate will cause a severe disruption in the supply of goods and services in the United States of America and, WHEREAS this mandate will cause severe economic hardship on small businesses and small trucking companies and, WHEREAS Canada has deferred the ELD mandate in that country for two years, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the South Dakota Association of Towns and Townships (SDATAT) goes on record supporting a two year delay in the implementation of the ELD mandate. And THEREFORE, BE IT ALSO RESOLVED: The South Dakota Association of Towns and Townships (SDATAT) supports a permanent exemption for small trucking companies, those with 50 trucks or less.
